Arrangement:

A corridor between Universitätsplatz and Getreidegasse in Salzburg, an arcade in a shopping mall near Frauenkirche in Dresden.

A slide projector situated in a showcase or placed on a small table. Images pop up. A woman? Machined slides appear in intervals of split seconds. The images disappear before one is able to realize what he has noticed.

Two subjects dressed in white block the way. They are singing. They are walking. They walk around – they walk back and forth. They sing to(wards) the passersby's and the loiterers.

Fragments of songs, well known popular songs, collages of texts.

Here (as well) appearance and disappearance. Vanish before the situation can be held.
